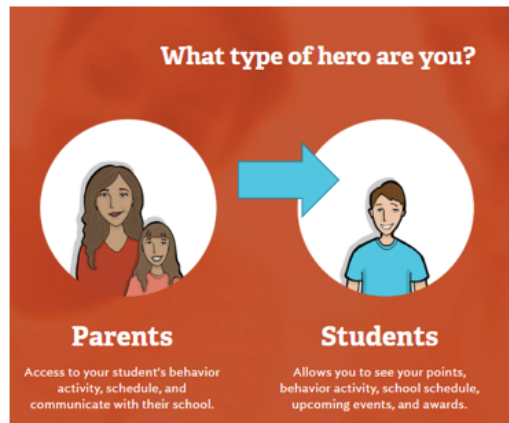


Let's Get Started

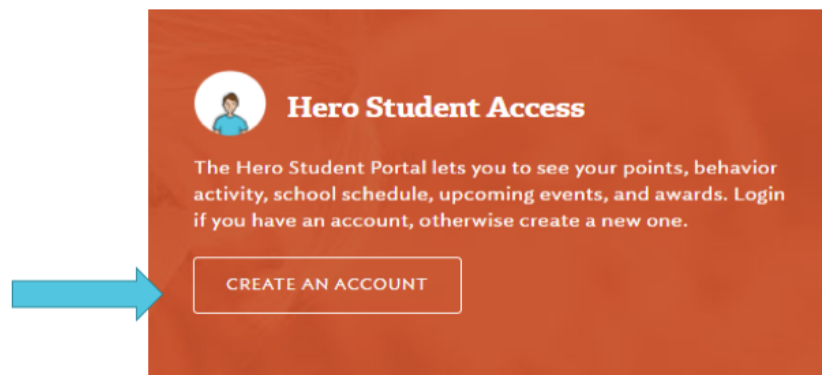
1) Go to <https://access.heropowered.com>

2) Click on STUDENTS



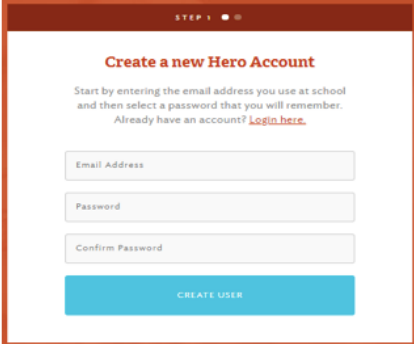

- 7) Click “CREATE USER”

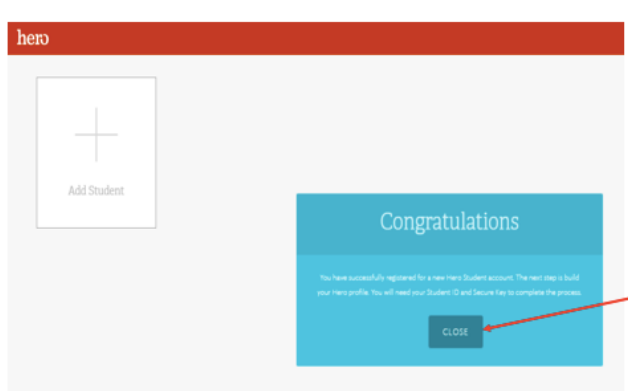

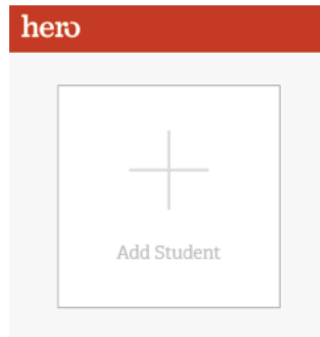

- 8) A blue pop-up menu will display; select “close”



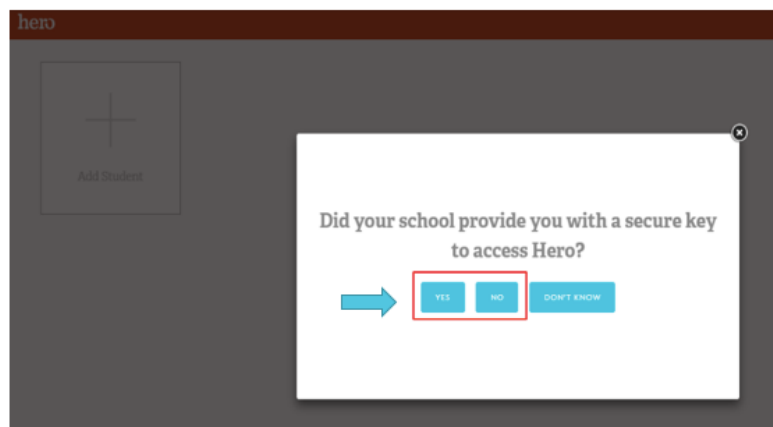
